

### 2024-2025 Executive Summary

#### **Overview & Goals**

For the 2024-2025 school year, the ECIS Library and Information Services Committee consisted of Rebecca Leonhard (chair), Vivienne Blake, Clare Brumpton, and Elizabeth DiCataldo. The three overall goals for the year were to arrange the next library conference, continue with the "Lessons From the Library" webinar series, and continue expanding outreach and enlarging our digital presence on social media.

#### **Goal #1: Next Library Conference**

Development of the next in-person library conference was the committee's top goal throughout the year. The committee explored several possible banquet and hotel options along with partnerships with additional international schools in Doha. Save the date notices and advertisements were shared in various formats on social media. Conference strands, requests for presentation proposals, a conference website, and final keynote announcements were all formally announced. A second keynote speaker, Helen Crompton, was confirmed. The library conference was supposed to take place in Doha, Qatar, on 15-17 May 2025 at Georgetown University Qatar, but the decision was made in February to cancel and postpone the conference due to low registration and proposal submissions. Management at ECIS later decided to convert the conference to a virtual format. It was decided that the new date for the virtual conference would be Saturday, 10 January 2026.
